#### LET'S MAKE MASKS

Materials to make your masks to be announced

#### MASK MAKING SUPPLIES

#### Masks

- 1. Pleated Mask
- 2. Pleated Mask with opening
- 3. Formed Mask

#### Supplies needed for each mask:

#### Mask #1

- 1. 8"x 9" rectangle 2 pieces
- 2. Pellon optional 1 piece same size
- 3. Elastic 2 pieces measuring 7" (1/8" preferable)

#### Mask #2

- 1. 12 x 12" (1) piece of material
- 2. 2 pieces of yarn for around the ears 7" long
- 3. Coffee filter in place of Pellon
- 4. Wire for across nose

#### Mask #3

- 1. Pattern for this mask
- 2. 20"x 22" piece of material (fold in 1/2 to cut material) Cut 4 pieces
- 3. 2 pieces of elastic 7" long
- 4. Pellon Cut 2 pieces

#### **HELPFUL HINTS**

- 1. Material should be 100% cotton but light cotton blends are fine. It is wise to have 2 different designs or colors so you can tell which side you were wearing next to your face in case you take it off intermittently.
- 2. A "Fat Quarter" works well for making 1 each of #1 & #3
- 3. Pellon is the same as stabilizer (used for lining collars and cuffs). It should be medium weight or it is harder to breathe through.
- 4. When cutting the pattern for the formed mask, make sure you have right sides together.
- 5. If you want to make the elastic go around the head you will need approximately 13" x 2 for an adult mask.
- 6. If making the formed mask, I could have wires to pick up the church. I'm coming up that way on September 1
- 7. A child's pleated mask is made the same way except material measures 6" x 7" and elastic about 5" depending on the child.




